Jesus **SHOWED** them how to serve. [John 13:15]

- He showed them how to LIVE through the practice of PRAYER and using SCRIPTURE.
- He led through demonstration not just explanation.
- Spiritual life is not about FEEDING only, but also about EXERCISE...the work of the ministry...serving...giving back!
- o All the disciples had to teach them was a teacher who practiced with them what He expected them to learn
- Watching Him, they learned what it was all about
- Jesus let His disciples see him in all life situations (wedding, family, teaching, prayer, healing, rejection, ridicule, suffering, death, resurrection)

DISCIPLESHIP: Living a	life.	
DISCIPLE: A believer who will	from Christ and	for Him.

DISCIPLESHIP DIMENSIONS:

- 1) **Bible Study:** Required nourishment for a healthy believer
- 2) Accountability: Don't walk alone. In-group spiritual accountability buddies
- 3) **Evangelism:** Share the new life you've found! Do outreach (monthly)
- 4) **Fellowship:** Spend time together often; formally; informally (monthly, bi-monthly)
- 5) **Spiritual Growth:** Spiritual growth is a result of the above. Do a Spiritual Gifts Assessment, Spiritual Growth Assessment, Personal Growth Plan.

- He sent them out in PAIRS (Mark 6:7; Matt 10:5; Luke 9:1-2
- The disciples were to be the actual **representatives** of Christ as they went forth 0

- They had to rely on him and comfort in one another
